- Reserve Challenge Certificates, (Pedigree classes only).
- Junior Warrant, (Pedigree classes only).

- Please do not bring bitches in season to this show
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times unless otherwise instructed.
- Always clean up after your dog and use the poo bags provided.
- Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Please make sure that no dog is brought to the show which has contracted or been knowingly exposed to any infectious or contagious disease during the 21 days prior to the show, or which is suffering from a visible condition which adversely affects its health or welfare.
